## Acetone

- Headaches
- Dizziness
- Irritated eyes, skin and throat

#### **Ethyl methacrylate** (EMA)

- Asthma
- Irritated eyes, skin, nose and mouth
- Difficulty concentrating
- Exposures while pregnant may affect vour child.

(Methyl methacrylate is banned in many states.)

# **Safety Data Sheets**

Salons must provide workers with safety data sheets (SDSs) for the products that contain hazardous chemicals.

## Toluene

- Dry or cracked skin
- Headaches, dizziness, and numbness
- Irritated eyes, nose, throat, and lungs
- Damage to liver and kidneys
- Can cause harm to unborn children during pregnancy.

## Formaldehyde


- Irritated eyes, skin and throat
- Asthma-like attacks
- Difficulty breathing
- Allergic reactions
- Can cause cancer.

# **Ventilate salons**

- Open doors and windows.
- Keep exhaust, heating & air conditions system on.
- Keep ventilation tables on.
- Use portable ventilation machines.

# **Protect your** eyes and skin

- Wear gloves and goggles.
- Wear long sleeved shirts.
- Wash hands frequently.
